HISTORIC VINEYARDS IN CALIFORNIA'S CENTRAL COAST

- At forefront of Chardonnay production in Edna Valley since planting first vineyards in 1973
- Nearly 80 acres planted to Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Rhone varieties just five miles from the ocean
- Purposefully sought fruit from best vineyards in Central Coast for single-vineyard Chardonnays and Pinot Noirs

AN IDEAL COOL CLIMATE LOCATION

- Edna Valley's longer growing season promotes exceptional development of flavors and structure
- Committed to ongoing exploration of quality and character in historic estate vineyards

SUSTAINABILITY AS A GUIDING PRINCIPLE

- Vineyards SIP (Sustainability in Practice) certified since 2010 and winery SIP-certified since 2016
- Compost, cover crops, minimal organic fertilizers, a rooftop solar array, drought-tolerant rootstock and water-recapture system that reclaims 100% of winery process water for irrigation

WALLA WALLA VALLEY HERITAGE

- Established in 1988 as the fifth winery in Walla Walla Valley, Seven Hills shaped the varietal focus of the appellation
- Winemaker Casey McClellan and his father planted the founding blocks of the original estate vineyard in the early 1980's
- Seven Hills Winery's original estate blocks were the first plantings to Bordeaux varietals in Walla Walla Valley
- 2018 marks the winery's 30th anniversary

MERLOT AND BORDEAUX RED BLEND LEADER

- A focus on site-driven, benchmark Merlot and Bordeaux-style red blends in Walla Walla Valley
- Varietal typicity, restrained oak and balanced acidity combine to create wines of structure and grace
- Longstanding relationships with the Northwest's most renowned vineyard sites over the winery's 30-year history
