WALLA WALLA VALLEY HERITAGE

- •Winemaker Casey McClellan and his father planted Seven Hills Vineyard in 1980, 100 years after his family began farming in Washington
- •Seven Hills Vineyard is the first Walla Walla vineyard planted to Bordeaux varietals, and the first commercial vineyard in the area
- •Established in 1988 as the fifth winery in Walla Walla Valley, Seven Hills Winery shaped the varietal focus of the appellation

OLD WORLD WINE STYLE

- •Seven Hills Winery produces wines known for varietal typicity
- •Restrained oak and balanced acidity combine to create structure and grace

- •These coastal growing conditions produce grapes that are highly aromatic, with the structure needed for the wine's balance and finesse
